

# THE BENEFITS OF INTERNET IN LEARNING ENGLISH FOR ENGLISH DEPARTMENT STUDENT

Abstract: This study aims to evaluate the perceptions related to the benefits of using the internet in English learning for fifth-semester students of the English Education Department. This research study used qualitative research. Instrument in this study was questionnaire, the data was collected from 15 statement items covering aspects such as the importance of the internet in learning, the benefits of using the internet, learning independence, improvement of language skills, and the positive impact of the internet in various language skills. There were 15 respondents who were asked to answer the questionnaire. Based on the questionnaire, the results showed that the majority of students agree that the internet is important in learning (73.3%) and provides significant benefits (60%). They also tend to agree that the internet improves learning independence (26.7%) and English language skills (33.3%). However, there were variations in perceptions regarding speaking and listening skills. Although most felt motivated by online content (46.7%), this study highlights the importance of developing teaching strategies that suit students' preferences and needs.

### 1. INTRODUCTION

The internet has become essential to many aspects of life in the rapidly evolving the digital era, including education. Technology is popular with everyone in every area, including education (Costley, 2014). One area that has significantly adopted this technological development is English language learning. In general, the use of the Internet in the context of English teaching provides many benefits for both teachers and students. According to Anderson (2008) argued that the internet or online learning provides flexible access, real-time interaction, and worldwide connections, even as instant content changes facilitate situated learning. Thus, the use of the Internet in English language learning not only expands accessibility to learning resources, but also opens up new opportunities for teachers and learners to improve their language skills. The use of technology in English language learning is increasingly widespread and productive for students (Van et al., 2021). Internet is the most popular source of information used to find the information needed.

It is important to understand that students as recipients of education have their own needs and demands. In the context of English language learning, the internet provides various advantages that can improve the quality of learning. Learners are not only limited to traditional textbooks, but can also utilize websites, learning videos, mobile applications, and online platforms specifically designed to improve language skills. According to Islam (2011) stated that the website cannot replace the library, but it has special functions that the library



does not have, such as search speed, immediate information, etc. In addition, interaction with various materials and online learning platforms can improve the quality of learning (Imran, 2023). Various online platforms provide interactive exercises, real-life simulations and communication with native speakers. We cannot always communicate with native English speakers face-to-face therefore using the Internet to learn English helps to compensate for the lack of common approaches without a real English environment (Islam, 2011). Thus, it can improve students' speaking, listening, reading and writing skills, producing graduates who are better prepared to face global demands.

Virtic (2012) explained that the Internet and Information and Communication Technologies have modernized education by introducing new methods, distance learning, and e-learning to better prepare students for life in the twenty-first century. In addition, the Internet also allows students to engage in online learning communities, whether through discussion forums, virtual classes, or joint projects. These interactions not only broaden their horizons to cultures and language variations, but also develop cooperation and communication skills in the digital environment in this modern era.

Several studies have been conducted regarding the use of the internet in learning, the students showed a good response to the use of the internet as a tool or media in assisting English learning. Research conducted on students' perspectives on internet utilization revealed that there are various positive perceptions given by students in learning ranging from infrastructure, quality of interaction, and usefulness received by students (Diana et al., 2021; Laksana, 2020). In the learning process by utilizing the internet as a complement to learning can effectively improve student learning outcomes and allow students to better control their own progress in mastering English (Tao, 2023; Prasetyo, 2021). This research aims to explore more deeply the benefits of using the internet in English language learning for students, considering the positive aspects that need to be known to maximize the potential of technology in improving the quality of education.

They were chosen as respondents because they have studied courses related to the internet and they keep in touch with the internet during lectures. Students who became respondents in this study were fifth semester students in the English Education Study Program of STKIP YPUP Makassar.

### 4. RESULTS

In this section the researcher presents the results and discussion. The researcher also describes the data collected from the questionnaire results. The questions in the questionnaire were designed to find out students' perceptions from very simple information. The results show that the majority of respondents (73.3%) strongly agreed that using the internet is very important in the process of learning English. Most of the respondents (60%) agreed that using the internet in English learning has many benefits. The majority of respondents (53.3%) feel that they can obtain relevant English learning resources through the internet. Most respondents (66.7%) agreed that the



internet improved their academic performance in English. The majority of respondents (80%) felt that using the internet in English learning can motivate them to be more actively involved in the learning process. Most respondents (73.3%) agreed that using the internet in learning English makes them more independent learners. The majority of respondents (66.7%) felt that using the internet in learning English helps improve language skills and knowledge. The majority of respondents (60%) agreed that the utilization of the internet in English language learning can facilitate the process of language acquisition. Most respondents (53.3%) felt that the internet made it easier for them to learn English reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. The majority of respondents (53.3%) feel more motivated to learn English because of access to various online content such as learning videos, podcasts and interactive materials. Most respondents (53.3%) felt that the internet helped them in taking online exams. The majority of respondents (53.3%) agreed that the internet helps make learning English interesting and enjoyable.

This result correlates with Agarwal (2010) claimed that independent internet English learning is one of the most significant learning strategies that accurately represents individual main concerns and learning orientations. The findings from the questionnaire presented a strong positive inclination towards the use of the internet in the English learning process, and students realized the benefits and positive impact of the internet on motivation, independence, and academic performance.

#### 6. CONCLUSION

The usage of the internet in English language learning procedures is unavoidable given its significant importance in English language instruction. Based on the data analysis, the researcher concludes that using the internet to study English has made a range of learning possibilities more inclusive, efficient, and enjoyable.
